- Know and be able to use the verbs “gustar” and “encantar” in the present and preterite tenses. (pp. 299, 300, 301 and class notes)
- Know and be able to use the “impersonal se” in Spanish. (p. 304 and class notes)

- Match vocabulary from p. 325.

- Translate from English into Spanish phrases similar to those done in class activities.

You will be able to use your book to do the reading, but not to answer the questions. All the questions must be answered in complete, Spanish sentences, which means they contain a subject or understood subject, a correctly conjugated verb and are logical.

You will be graded on the following:

Pronunciation and speed of reading =	50 pts.
Comprehension of the question asked =	25 pts.
Correctness of the response given to the questions =	25 pts.
Total =	100 pts.

- ¿Cuál es la más antigua universidad de España?
- ¿Cuándo se funda la Universidad de Salamanca?
- ¿Quién fundó la Universidad de Salamanca?
- ¿Cuántos estudiantes hay en la Universidad de Salamanca?
- ¿Dónde está la primera universidad de América Latina?
- ¿Quién estableció la primera universidad de América Latina?
- ¿Cuántos campus tiene la primera universidad de América Latina?
- ¿Cuántos estudiantes tiene la Universidad de Santo Domingo?
- ¿Qué por ciento de los estudiantes en la Universidad de Santo Domingo son mujeres?
